

Explanation

X = New Batter

X = ~~NEW~~ First Pitch by new Batter

/ = Subsequent pitch by Batter.

Ⓝ = Number of pitches that signifies how many days of rest is required by this pitcher.

* In the example, Lowell pitched a total of 22 pitches, however he was in the middle of a Batter when he reached the limit for 0 days of rest. Since he was removed from game after this batter, the reported pitch count should be 20. This means that Lowell does not have to rest before he pitches again.

* The same goes for Smith, however he must serve (1) days rest because he went past 20 pitches with 2 or more Batters.
