MEMORANDUM FOR: WAMAC SPORTS/ATHLETIC DIRECTORS, COACHES, AND PLAYERS

SUBJECT: '22-23 Washington Area Military Athletic Conference (WAMAC) Men's Basketball Program

Chairman: Michael Perry, Joint Base Anacostia Bolling

Community Chair: JB Anacostia-Bolling, NSA Bethesda, JB Langley-Eustis, JB Myer Henderson Hall, JB Andrews, Fort Belvoir, Fort Lee and Dover AFB

The Community Chair Sports office can designate an alternate person outside of the sports office for voting purposes. The designation must be recieved in writting from the sports office to the Chairman with the full name and expiration date of authority.

### 1. REFERENCE:

- a. Washington Area Military Athletic Conference Constitution.
- b. NCAA Basketball Rules except where modified by WAMAC Constitution.
- 2. **PURPOSE:** To provide information and outline responsibilities for the conduct of 2022-2023 WAMAC Basketball Program.
- 3. **PARTICIPATION:** Each WAMAC member may enter a male team. All team members are subject to the player eligibility rules as outlined in the WAMAC Constitution.

#### 4. **ELIGIBILITY:**

- a. Only Active Duty, Reservist, National Guard ID Card holders and four (4) civilian Employees (DoD civilians, Retirees and or Dependents 18 years of age) who are assigned/work on the actual installation represented will be allowed to participate in the Men's Division. (High School and Collegiate level players are not allowed)
  - If a team <u>has</u> a contractor, that player will be included within the 4 civilian category (3 civilians, 1 contractor)
  - □ If a team **does not** have a contractor it will remain as 4 civilians
  - Cut off point to allow a contractor on a team will be halfway through the regular season.

Eligible personnel must participate with the installation to which they are assigned or attached. Teams caught with illegal player will result as a forfeit. Any player or combined installation participating prior to approval from WAMAC Chairperson is considered ineligible. DoD civilians and Contractors cannot transfer from bases.

- b. Participants from team/installations that fold (dropped from league, etc.) during a sport season will not be allowed to play with any other installation during the remainder of the season, league or championship.
- c. In the event a player should receive military orders to another installation within the WAMAC League, the individual concerned has the option of playing with the team he started with or the new Team.

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New rosters from both Installations must be signed and submitted by the Sports Director to the Commissioner by 1200 Friday before the next scheduled game.

- d. Eligibility will be handled in the following manner: 100% ID card checks must be conducted by the Sports Director/Fitness staff and or Coaching Staff prior to the beginning of the game. It is the responsibility of the Sports Director to ensure that everyone listed on the roster is assigned or attached to their installation. 100% ID card check will also be conducted at the Championship Tournament. Random ID card checks may be done at the discretion of the WAMAC Commissioner at ANYTIME!!!
- e. All individuals who fit within WAMAC guidelines but are not a part of a WAMAC playing installation will submit their name into the WAMAC office where players will be divided first among the teams who need players, then divided the rest of those players among the rest of the WAMAC.

#### 5. **GENERAL**:

- a. League play will be conducted and each team will be advancing to the WAMAC Double Elimination Championships:
  - (1) Registration deadline is Friday, 16 December 2022
  - (2) Entry Fee of \$0
  - (3) League begins play on Saturday, 7 January 2023

- (4) Men's Championship at JBAB
- (5) WAMAC All Star Weekend (After League's conclusion)@ Joint Base Anacostia-Bolling
- b. **Schedule:** All league games will be scheduled on Friday Saturday or Sunday with the following times:

Friday, Saturday and Sunday Friday: 1900

Saturday & Sunday: 1300 and 1500

- c. Tournament: All registered WAMAC teams
- d. **Forfeits:** Game time is Forfeit time. 2 forfeits and your team will be disqualified from the league.
- e. Changes to Schedule: Any changes in game time/game dates must be agreed upon by both Sport/Athletic Directors and reported to the WAMAC Office as soon as possible.
- f. Teams who cancel due to mission requirement are responsible for coordinating that make up game with the League Commissioner and opposing team. Arrangements for makeup games **should** be coordinated within two weeks of the originally scheduled game date or be considered a loss by the team requesting a schedule change. The email must come from the cancelling teams installations Sports office.
- g. There will be an open roster during regular season; however, team may dress only 15 players per contest per game.
  - A. First and Last name of every player participating must be entered into the official scorebook (no nicknames). It is the <u>responsibility of the home team</u> to fax or <u>e-mail game results</u> to the WAMAC Office NLT COB of the 1<sup>st</sup> Monday after the game.
  - B. Updated/edited rosters signed by sports director must be received by Friday @ 1200. NO EXCEPTIONS!
  - ☐ Friday Night games rosters are due Thursday @ 1200
  - C. The roster submitted for the last scheduled game will be used for tournament play. Exceptions will only be made for Active-Duty PCS on orders (MUST PROVIDE ORDERS)

- f. The following tiebreaker rules will be used:
  - (1) Best Division/league record
  - (2) Head to Head
  - (3) Head to Head point differential
  - (4) All teams in division point differential

## 6. AWARDS:

- a. 1<sup>st</sup> Place Team Awards for the League
- b. 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, and 3<sup>rd</sup> Place Team Awards for the Championship
- c. 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> Place Individual Awards for the Championship
- d.Most Valuable Player Award for the regular season and Championship
- e. Coach of the Year
