

BECOMING A COACH

Application

All head and assistant coaches must complete a youth basketball coaching form. The form is attached to this packet. You may also go online to www.quickscores.com/desoto and complete the form electronically.

Criminal Background Screening

All coaches must pass a background check once a year. A list will be posted on www.quickscores.com/desoto each Monday by 5:00 p.m. You may also contact the DeSoto Parks and Recreation office at 972-230-9650 for results. The list at the office is updated every 24 – 48 hours. The list will indicate if you are approved or if you need to complete additional information.

NAYS Coaches Certification

All coaches must be certified once a year and if a multi-sport coach they will need to attend a skills training class for each sport that they coach every year by NAYS (National Alliance for Youth Sports).

Coaches will be required to complete and pass a two-part coaches certification course. The National Youth Sports Coaches Association (NYSCA) offers certification training for youth sports coaches through the National Alliance for Youth Sports (NAYS), an organization dedicated to improving out-of-school youth sports by raising awareness through leadership, education, and advocacy. This course can be taken online.

Once you have completed your NAYS Certification please make sure you contact their representative and have them place you under the DeSoto Parks and Recreation.

Orientation

Attend one hour volunteer orientation with the City. You will only need to attend this orientation once a year and it covers all sports. The next orientation will be scheduled for mid-December. You will be able to start practices without orientation if you have completed your background check and certification but will not be able to coach in a game until orientation is completed.

Practices

In order to start practices you must complete the criteria listed above. In addition, you will need to have at least six players who have registered. No players are permitted to start practice until they have registered through the DeSoto Parks and Recreation.

The roster limit for each age division will be 10 players. Teams may be permitted to go over the 10 player limit with approval.
