Division Basketball Rules



General Rules:

- Coaches/Captains will be responsible for distributing and informing players and parents of schedules, rules, conduct, and any other information set forth by league coordinators
- Players must wear tennis shoes. No hard soles or sandals.
- Participants may not wear any jewelry
- On the bench: only players on the roster and up to 2 coaches will be allowed on the bench before, during and after the games.
- Participant's names must be on the roster and signed by the end of the season to participate in the end of season tournament. Participants also must play in at least 2 games to qualify for the tournament
- No food or drink on the court
- Absolutely no gum on the court
- Farmington City is a ZERO tolerance league
- League rules are listed on the next page
- Dunking is only allowed during game time. **NOT** during warmups or after the games. No hanging on the rim.
- Home team is listed first on the schedule and will wear the white jerseys.
- Each Team **MUST** have a parent on the bench to be the teams coach. If they do not have a **PARENT** coach it will be an automatic forfeit for that team.

Competition:

- Teams must wear their Jr. Jazz jersey from the current season
- Players may only play on one team in league.
- Coaches must remain on the sidelines and may not enter the court unless a time out has been called
- League standings will be posted do to the post-season tournament.
- Team Division needs at least 4 players at game time to start and needs to finish the game with 4 players or else there will be a forfeit
- 2 minute overtime; if needed, additional overtime will be given, the first team to score a point will end the game.

Sportsmanship:

- Coaches should encourage players to practice good sportsmanship behaviors
- Coaches also should practice good sportsmanship behaviors
- Remember that this is a game and we are here to have fun and develop the talents of those in our program
- Coaches, parents, or players with negative behavior towards officials, recreation staff, or other participants will result in removal from the premises and possible removal from the program. Extreme negative behavior could result in a ban from all Farmington recreational activities in the future. Such behavior could include but are not limited to the following:
 - Speaking Aggressively toward participants, referees, or fans
 - Inappropriate language or swearing
 - Physically harming another individual
 - Unwillingness to follow city rules or policies
 - Unfair treatment of players

Age	Jr. High School – High School Team Divisions
Game Timing	Two 18 minute halves
Time outs	<p>2 (30sec) per half Timeouts do not carry over from 1st to 2nd half</p> <p>* All spectators must remain on the bleachers. We will not allow anyone to take the court during timeouts or halftime.</p>
Clock	Running until last 2 minutes of each half
Overtime	<p>YES- 2-minute overtime, additional over time will be given if needed, the game will end when the first team scores.</p>
Rules	<p>Will play by High School Rules This includes:</p> <p>* 2 Technicals from a player will have them out for the remainder of the game</p> <p>* 3 Technicals from a player will have them out for the remainder of the season</p> <p>“Fan Policy” – Any fan removed from a game can’t come back for the duration of the season.
