#### GENERAL INFORMATION

Location: The Ballpark at Erie (401 Powers St, Erie)

Date: Thursday, 7/24 (evening)  
Saturday, 7/26 (morning/afternoon)  
Sunday, 7/27 (morning/afternoon)

Format: Single-Elimination

#### TOURNAMENT INFORMATION

Who can participate: All Pee Wee teams are invited to participate. There will be two divisions:  
Gold Division: Consists of the upper 50% of teams from both regular-season leagues  
Silver Division: Consists of the lower 50% of teams from both regular-season leagues

Tournament Seeding: Winning percentage will determine tournament seeding (higher seed is home team). The following tiebreaker will be used:  
a) Head-To-Head  
b) Head-To-Head Run Differential  
c) Total Runs For  
d) Coin Toss (performed by Erie Parks & Recreation)

**How to participate:** Teams must confirm their intent to play in the tournament by **Friday, 7/11**. Please email or call Alexis Rankey at [arankey@erieco.gov](mailto:arankey@erieco.gov) or 303.926.2790. Teams that do not confirm intent by the deadline will not be allowed to participate.

#### TOURNAMENT RULES

Same as Four Star Pee Wee regular-season rules with the following exceptions:

- Game Time:** Game time is forfeit time. Teams must be ready to play when scheduled. No grace period.
- Time Limit:** The time limit for all games is 75 minutes. The championship game time limit is 90 minutes. When approaching the time limit, if there is no chance for a team to come back and tie due to the 6-run per inning rule, the inning will not be played and the game will be considered final.
- Defensive Time Limit:** Teams have one-minute to be on the field and ready to play (catcher included). The penalty for any delay is one ball called for every 15 seconds.
- Rosters:** All coaches must have a team roster with them and all players must be on the roster. Rosters that indicate age and/or date of birth are preferred but not required. If a player is on a team roster, it is assumed that he or she is the correct age.
- Pictures:** Erie must receive a hats-off team photo for every team in the tournament by Thursday, 7/17. If your team photos were taken by Hoffer Photo, we will automatically receive a copy. If not, please send.
- Tiebreakers:** Same as regular season - International Rule. The visiting team will place one runner at second base and bat until three outs. The home team will then have a turn at bat with a runner at second. If still tied after two innings, runners will be placed on second and third and the game will continue until one team wins.
