# LAYTON CITY RECREATION <br> MENS OPEN BASKETBALL RULES <br> REVISED January 6, 2023

#### Abstract

Players must play in two (2) games to be eligible to play in tournament. No exceptions. If your team attempts to play with a player that is not eligible for tournament, your team will forfeit the rest of your tournament games. It is the responsibility of Layton City, Layton City staff member and/or the opposing team to determine if a player is eligible for tournament play.


## Players may only be on one roster.

1. Rosters are due at the first game with all information complete \& signed. There will be no grace period to hand in the roster. If rosters are not handed in before the first game of play, teams will forfeit their games until the rosters are handed in. If the roster is not handed in by the second week of play, the team captain will be notified of termination of league play without a refund. At tournament time there will be no additions or changes. Legal tournament players must have played in two league games.
2. Games are two 18 -minute halves, with a running clock until the last $\mathbf{3 0}$ seconds of first half and last 1 minute of the game. This includes shooting foul shots. The clock will stop for time-outs. Half time will be 3 minutes, to be determined by the supervisor. Each team is allowed two time-outs per half. No carry overs.
3. Overtime is three minutes. The clock will stop in the last minute with one timeout per team.
4. Game time is game time. There will be no grace period for any game. Each team must have four players to start and finish the game. If a team has four players and a player fouls out, is ejected, gets injured, or otherwise cannot finish the game, the team will forfeit the game.
5. All teams must provide their own uniforms. Uniforms need to be the same color with a $4 "-6$ " contrasting number on the back. If a player does not have a uniform, they cannot play in the game.
6. Players must be $\mathbf{1 6}$ years or older. Any player under 18 will need to have a parent or guardian fill out and sign a waiver. Waivers can be received at the Recreation Office Monday - Friday from 8am - 5:00pm.

PENALTY: If a team is caught with a player that is younger than 16 years old that team will forfeit the season with no refund.

ID'S WILL BE REQUIRED AT TOURNAMENT TIME. IF YOU DO NOT HAVE THEM YOU WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO PLAY. If a team brings in an ineligible player during tournament play, that team forfeits the remainder of the season.
7. Protests: Notification of intent to protest MUST be made BEFORE play resumes. The manager shall immediately notify the head official and the scorekeeper that the game is being continued under protest. Protests then must be filed in writing at the recreation office by $5: 00 \mathrm{pm}$ the following work day with a $\$ 50.00$ protest fee. If the protest is upheld, the check is returned. Protest forms are available from the scorekeeper.
8. CONDUCT: As a manager or team representative, you are responsible for your team. The officials, site supervisors, and scorekeepers have been encouraged to be quick to correct any abusive language or actions. My personal philosophy, THERE ARE NO WARNINGS. If your behavior would offend any member of my family or embarrass yours any recreation department personnel, at any time, have the right to ask you to leave the gym and possibly the program.
9. In the unlikely event of an "ejection", the player will leave the facility \& not return to the facility for TWO games. With the first technical, the player is required to sit for 5 minutes. If it occurs at the end of a game, they will be required to sit out the remainder plus the beginning of the next scheduled game. Chronic offenders will be suspended for the season at the judgement of the scorekeeper and/or site supervisor.
10. If a team is removed from the league for disciplinary reasons, their registration fees will NOT be reimbursed.

If in the event that you, the team manager, withdraw your team from the program on or after the day of the Manager's meeting, there will be a $\$ 25.00$ Handling Fee. This fee will be taken out of the refund check.
