•**Fees:** The fee for Instructional players (4 and 5 year olds) is \$40. The fee for all other players is \$60 for one player, \$100 for two players, and \$125 for three or more players in the same family. (No refunds. You are paying for both fall and spring seasons. Make check payable to "OYSA".) Fees are waived for OYSA board members, and halved for coaches and assistant coaches. If paying full fees would be rough, please request financial aid from the Board (oyasa-soccer@live.com), or submit a WRITTEN request with your registration form.

•**Age documentation required (U9 and older):** All players in age group U9, and players in older age groups new to OYSA, must submit **ONE photocopy of their birth certificate or passport.** (This Ohio League requirement verifies the player's age.) Returning players do **NOT** need to resubmit this every year.

•**Photo (U9 and older):** Each **NEW** player **U9 and up** must submit a **small photograph** of his or her face, with his or her name printed clearly on the back. (This photo will become a part of his or her player pass)

PLEASE NOTE: New for 2010! Returning players **DO NOT** need to submit a photo. Current passes will be valid and updated with dated stickers in the future.

•**Registration procedure:** This form registers a player for *both* the Fall 2010 and Spring 2011 seasons. Complete a separate registration form for each child. Submit completed registration packets (this registration form, check, age documentation, and photo) as follows:

Returning players: As a current soccer player, you have first priority for placement on next year's team. To take advantage of that priority, you must return your completed registration packet to your **coach** by **June 5th, 2010**.

New players: Registration packets are due by **Monday, August 13th, 2010**. Please mail completed registration packets to:

Late registrations will be accepted as long as there is space available on the roster until the LCSL deadline (usually the week of the first game) but late registrants may miss one or more games and will pay a \$10 surcharge.

•**Important Double-Card Rule:**
Player Removal

If your son or daughter elects to play on an additional team other than their primary team due to open roster slots, he or she is the first to be removed in the event a new player should register by the LCSL deadline.
