The girls play games on Saturdays. All games are played at Skokie area gyms, with locations varying by division. The season begins the last two weekends in October with the pre-season BASKETBALL BASH at the Weber Center (times TBA). Evaluations and practice continue in November, with practice games in December. Regular season games begin on January 9 and 10 and end in mid-March. 4<sup>th</sup> thru 8<sup>th</sup> grade teams have one weeknight practice per week. Younger divisions have short practices immediately prior to the weekend games.
