

Field Preparation Before the Game

(Visiting Team Responsibilities)

- 1. Open the parking lot gate and secure in the open position.
- 2. Get the keys from the press box storage room. Open locks on all field gates (near both dugouts, and double gate down the left field line).
- **3.** Open both restroom doors and the kitchen door.
- 4. Get the chalk machine from the press box storage room and fill halfway with chalk as directed. Take the chalk machine and twine/stakes to the field.
- 5. Line the field (see diagram on next page).
- 6. Install the bases and place the pitcher's screen near the pitcher's rubber.
- 7. Return the chalk machine and twine/stakes to the press box storage room.
- 8. Return the field keys to the press box storage room.





Field Preparation After the Game (Home Team Responsibilities)

- 1. Move the pitcher's screen from the field to the 3rd base dugout.
- 2. Remove the bases from the field, insert the anchor covers in the base holes, and store the bases in the 3rd base dugout storage box.
- **3.** Using a push broom sweep the turf batter's box.
- 4. Hand rake around bases, pitcher's mound, along the fence line and the 3' area next to the outfield grass.
- 5. Clean dugouts of all trash and sweep.
- 6. Drag the field with the tractor (or the hand pull drag mat). **KEEP DRAG TRACTOR AT LEAST 3' FROM THE OUTFIELD GRASS.** Start at least 3' from the outfield grass and make overlapping circles toward the pitcher's rubber until the entire infield has been covered.
- 7. Secure the tractor and lock double gates in left field.
- 8. Lock both field gates, restrooms, kitchen, press box storage room.
- 9. Return keys to press box storage room before leaving and locking the parking lot gate.
