

# San Mateo Fall 2009 Adult Coed Dodgeball League

TO: Anyone Interested in Adult Coed Dodgeball  
FROM: San Mateo Recreation Department

Thank you for your interest in the *Fall* season of *San Mateo's Adult Coed Dodgeball League*. The Fall Season begins Sunday, August 30th at SMHS. We have outlined for you below what steps you need to take in order to register your team(s). We accept teams in the chronological order in which they register, provided their registration forms and fees are correct and complete. By registering early, you increase your chances of being accepted into the league of your choice and skill level.

## **Registrations –DEADLINE FRIDAY, August 21st, 2009 5:00pm**

Registrations must be hand delivered or mailed to our **Athletics Office, 2001 Pacific Boulevard, San Mateo, CA 94403**. Our office will be open from 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. on weekdays. Your registration will be time/date stamped. **Please deliver your registration in an envelope with your team name.** Leagues will not be formed until after May 29th at the earliest, so please do not call us to see if the Coed Dodgeball League is filled. Be as flexible as you can and we will try our best to accommodate your team.

San Mateo uses NADA sanctioned rules (<http://www.dodgeballusa.com/rules.html>), and our games are officiated by trained city employees. San Mateo reserves the right to make rule modifications/additions at any time.

Each team has a 5 match schedule. Each match consists of twelve 5 minute games with a 5 minute intermission after 6 games. Every game is concluded when all the players have been eliminated on one team or when time runs out (each game is 5 minutes). If time runs out and both teams have an equal # of players remaining the teams will play sudden death dodgeball with the remaining players. In sudden death the remaining players will all start off the game in the same format (players on the endline and balls in the middle) as they would at the start of each game.

The top four teams then play in a single-elimination playoff at the end of the season to determine the league championship. The team with the best overall record will receive t-shirts as the Division Winner. Teams winning the Championship game will receive a team trophy or t-shirts.

## REGISTRATION REQUIREMENTS:

1. **League fees of \$350** in the form of a cashier's check, money order, sponsor's check, or credit card (Visa or MC). ***NO PERSONAL CHECKS*** and ***NO CASH***. Please make checks payable to: ***San Mateo Recreation Dept.***
2. A **team roster** form (enclosed) complete with player names, addresses, phone numbers, and signatures. Rosters must include a minimum of 10 players, and a maximum of 15 (men), or 18 (coed). Rosters must be either typed or neatly hand printed. **ALL TEAMS, EVEN RETURNING TEAMS, MUST SUBMIT A COMPLETED ROSTER FORM.**
3. **Proof of San Mateo residency** from just one member on your team roster. Please include a copy of the resident's driver's license, or other picture I.D. that states the participant's address.
4. Completed **League Entry Request Form (MANDATORY)**

## REMINDER NOTES:

1. There will be a **Mandatory Manager's Meeting** for **ALL teams**. Please be sure to have a representative at the meeting for important information. This meeting's time and location are yet TBD. The team manager will be notified in regards to the manager's meeting.
2. Matching uniforms **ARE NOT REQUIRED**.
3. **Creative uniforms are encouraged**. Please do not wear anything that could be dangerous such as earrings, chains, piercings of any sort, or slippery shoes. No hats are allowed.
4. If you have any unique scheduling conflicts or requests, please include them with your Entry Request Form. We will try to accommodate your requests, but we cannot promise or guarantee them.
5. **PLAYERS MUST FILL OUT AND SIGN THE ROSTER/WAIVER FORM BEFORE PLAYING IN ANY GAME.**
6. **No players are to be added after the 3<sup>rd</sup> match without the League Director's permission. All added/dropped players must be done using the Add/Drop form.**
