POLICY STATEMENT # 8

PLAYER REGISTRATION GUIDELINES

August 22, 2018

As more people who want to play softball have moved into Pebble Creek, the PCSSA has expanded the number of teams formed to accommodate the increasing numbers of players registered. The PCSSA wants to continue to provide the opportunity to play softball for players of all ability levels in Pebble Creek. At the same time, the PCSSA plays on only one field. Accordingly, the PCSSA adopts the following policy beginning with the 2018-19 league year.

1. As has been done in the past years, registration for returning and new players will occur during the summer. The PCSSA Board of Directors will decide the number of teams to be formed for the year based on the number of registering players. A player draft to provide 12 players per team will be conducted in September each year.
2. Any player registered and assigned to a team during the 2017-18 league year is guaranteed to be drafted onto a team as long as he or she timely registers and continues to play in the PCSSA in all future years. Any player on the substitute list for 2017-18 league year, or who first register to play in any subsequent year, may be drafted onto a team, but is not guaranteed to be drafted for any future year.
3. In the event the number of players registering for the year does not provide exactly 12 players per team, the Board will form as many teams of 12 each as the number of registrants allows, leaving a number of players fewer than 12 who will not be drafted onto a team. These players will be placed on the substitute list for the season.
