

National Division Recap:

Congratulations to the "Silver Spring Foods" team on achieving the double sweep of winning the "National Division Championship" with a 14-5 playoff victory over "Arizona Orthopedic PT," and winning the "End-of-Season Tournament" with a 20-6 victory over "Anasazi Pools."

Silver Spring won the Fall session with an 11-2 record and amassed a combined record of 29-10 over the Fall, Mid-Winter and Winter sessions, which earned them the #1 seeding for the End-of-Season Tournament.

Spring Season:

- Spring draft is complete and teams have been assembled four American and four National Division teams will compete on Tuesdays and Saturdays, April 11-June 10.
- Game time for first game of the day is 8:00am
- P.A. Announcers will be used sporadically (only on opening day and every-other-Saturday)
- Both the American and National Divisions will be "trying out" a new "Substitute Runner Provision for Pitchers." If a pitcher is on base with two outs, he or she may request a substitute runner (using the same PCSSA sub runner process) to allow more time to return to the dugout and reassemble protective equipment before the new start of the next half inning.
- Both the American and National Divisions will also be "trying out" a 6-outs-on, 6-off format to gauge the impact on game time length. This will be over a three consecutive game period in May (dates TBD).
- The American Division only will be "trying out" 70' bases for three consecutive games during April (dates TBD)
- A hot-dog day is planned for the final day, June 10th
