



Play Resumes January 2nd:

Games resume on Monday, January 2nd with four National League games.

- The National League continues its 2nd trimester which concludes on Saturday, February 4th.

Frost Delays & Length of Games:

We have already had a couple frost delays and will likely continue to have sporadic delays through January.
