COVID-19 PROTOCOL POLICY
Updated 3/9/22

The AZ Traditions Softball Club (Softball Club) adheres to all local and national health care advisors and recommendations regarding the transmission of COVID-19 and / or any / all transmittable diseases or viruses. Any player who may exhibit symptoms, is feeling ill/sick, shall be asked to stay home or leave the playing complex. If a player, manager, or league official has tested positive for COVID-19, that individual must remain out of contact for at least five (5) days, have a negative COVID test, and are symptom free prior to returning as an active player, manager, or resuming league duties.

The following “Distancing Practices” and “Protective Measures” are adopted by the AZ Traditions Softball Club and are mandated or recommended by the CDC, AZ Traditions HOA Board & Maricopa County, and will be re-addressed on a periodic basis. These steps have been put in place to assist in the prevention of spreading the COVID-19 virus.

- a. All players, coaches and managers should practice social distancing when practical.
- b. Masks are not required but can be worn and are recommended for our players with underlying conditions.
- c. Any player of the Softball Club who believes, or exhibits any symptoms of COVID-19 (fever, coughing, mild to severe respiratory illness, or any other symptoms identified by the CDC), or sickness away from the ball field, will notify their manager immediately by telephone and remain away from the ball field for a minimum of 3-5 days. If a player has COVID-19 symptoms and they dissipate after (3-5) days, and the player has tested for COVID-19 with test results as negative, the player may return to the ball field.

Any player who exhibits, or has notified his/her manager of COVID-19 symptoms at the ball field, will immediately leave the ball field, and remain away from the ball field for a minimum of five (5) days or until completion of a negative COVID-19 test. The Softball Club will conduct a follow-up informational interview with the player to determine results of any COVID-19 test or condition of symptoms.

The Softball Club will inform league players if a player or Softball Club personnel has tested positive for COVID-19 and of possible exposure. If during the follow-up informational interview, it is determined there was no possibility of exposure to

other players, continued league play will be at the discretion of the Softball Club.

- d. Any player who has tested positive for COVID-19, will remain away from the ball field for a minimum of five (5) days. At the end of the five (5) day period, the following conditions must be met:
1. The player exhibits no COVID-19 symptoms;
 2. The player has completed a second negative COVID-19 test.

The Softball Club will have final say when determining if a player will be cleared for re-instatement to league play.
