

Hurricane Recreation T-Ball Rules

- Each game will be (4) innings long with a time limit of one (1) hour. No inning shall start after 45 minutes of play, but inning will be completed if started.
- Home team is responsible to set up the bases on the field and shall occupy the third base sideline. Visiting team will occupy the first base sideline.
- Each inning, both teams will bat their entire line-up. The three out rule will not apply. All other standard baseball rules will be enforced (ex. If a fly ball is caught the batter is out etc...)
- There can be only two (2) offensive base coaches on the field (first and third bases).
- Two (2) defensive coaches may position themselves in outfield foul territory, one on each foul line.
- Every player bats and batting orders remain the same throughout the game.
- All players on the team will be allowed on the field for defense. However, there will be a limit of six (6) standard infield players, including the pitcher and catcher. The remaining players must be positioned in the outfield grass.
- Each inning, the defensive players must play a different position than they previously played in the previous inning.
- Every offensive player must wear a helmet when batting or running the bases. Helmets should also be worn during practices.
- Home team is responsible for providing the bases and balls for the game. The baseball MUST be an official T-Ball baseball.
- Coaches are responsible for "T" adjustments of individual batters.
- If a batter would prefer to be pitched to, they will be allowed a maximum of 3 pitches before the tee must be used.
- The tee must be removed when a runner is coming into home plate.
- There will be no infield fly rule in T-ball.
- A batter is allowed a maximum of five (5) swings to put the ball in fair play. After five (5) swings, the batter is out.
