- I will do my very best to provide a safe play situation for my players.
- I will do my best to organize practices that are fun and challenging to my players and fans.
- I will follow all League Rules during League games and during Championship/Tournament Play.
- I will ensure that I am knowledgeable of the rules as a coach and I will teach these rules to my players.
- I will use those coaching techniques appropriate for each of the skills I teach, keeping the player's health and well-being in mind.
- I will remember that I am a Youth Coach and that the game is for children and not adults. I will not adhere to a win at all cost.**

No profanity from the bench or field. No tobacco of any kind. Absolutely NO alcoholic beverages allowed on or around fields, dugouts, concession area and bleachers. NO glass containers of any kind. Fence Climbing will not be permitted.

The Director & Assistant Director of Parks & Recreation has the authority to expel any coach (manager), player, team or spectator from the league, permanently or temporarily, at any time, with no refund. The involved coach (manager), player (s), team or spectator is entitled to a hearing, before disciplinary action will be taken with the Director of Parks & Recreation. If it is a player(s) involved, one or both parents must be present at the hearing. **I AGREE TO ACCEPT THE DIRECTOR'S DECISION COMPLETELY.**
