With guidance from the El Paso Health Department and Office of Emergency Management, the El Paso Parks and Recreation Department will be allowing the following:

- Youth: Two parents or legal guardians and siblings living in the same household.
- Adult: Immediate family members living in the same household.

These guidelines are effective immediately.

In order to discourage spread of COVID-19, families are asked to social distance at least six feet apart from other families, not to congregate in large groups, and no additional spectators will be allowed. Face coverings are not required but are encouraged at all times unless actively participating or eating/drinking.
