EL PASO PARKS AND RECREATION YOUTH PLAYER ID REGULATIONS

All Youth Players, (**Ages 17 and Under**) participating in El Paso Parks and Recreation Department (EPPARD) Sports Programming are required to have a Youth Player ID. (**No Exceptions**) ID's can be obtained at any of your local EPPARD Recreation Centers or Sports Centers.

You Must:

1. Complete Parent Class. Parent Class cost \$7.00 and can be completed on a Walk-In basis. Class last approximately 15 minutes.
2. Provide proof of **Original Birth Certificate**, (alternative documents accepted include: **Military ID, Pass-Port, State or Federal ID, or School Demographics Sheet.**) You must provide an original copy of one of the aforementioned documents or you will be unable to obtain a Youth Players ID. (**No Exceptions**)
3. Your child must be present at the time of purchased of the Youth Player ID Card to take their photo for their ID. (**No Exceptions**)
4. Youth Player ID's cost \$5.00 and are valid for **One Year** from date of purchase.
5. If you lose your Youth Player ID card, it can be reprinted at a \$5.00 replacement fee.
6. In order to renew a Youth Player ID: Steps 1 through 5 must be completed every year.
