## Safety Protocols for Local & State Track Meets

- It is highly recommended for staff to wear masks and gloves during the entirety of the event.
- It is highly recommended that participants wear masks while awaiting their event.
- It is highly recommended that spectators wear masks at all times.
- Announcements will be made regularly reminding spectators to social distance. If social distancing is not adhered to, the event can be shut down.
- No high fives, fist bumps or contact of any nature during the entirety of the event.
- Each field event will have a hand sanitization station.
- Each participant must use hand sanitizer before and after any attempt at their event.
- No spectators will be allowed to stand on the fencing at the front row of the bleachers.
- Participants must be socially distanced while awaiting their event.
- Spectators, coaches and athletes will not be allowed to congregate near the bullpen entrance or the gate at the finish line.
- Tents will only be allowed on top row of bleachers
- TENTS WILL NOT BE ALLOWED IN FRONT OF THE CONCESSION STAND AREA AS THEY HAVE IN THE PAST. NO TENTS ON GRASS AREAS!!!
- EMS is there for patrons, athletes and staff in case they feel sick; announcer will make frequent PSAs to notify location.
- Include "Checklist for Coaches" , "Keep Youth Athletes Safe" , "How to Protect Yourself & Others" & "Stop the Spread of Germs" CDC guidelines handouts in all department/team packets.
- Provide "How to Protect yourself & others" CDC guidelines handouts to all staff during employee roll call and provide prior to for review.
- There will not be chairs provided for staff. Bring your own chairs due to sanitary reasons.
- Discourage spitting; encourage athletes to sneeze and cough into elbow or tissue.
- Athletes that are participating in the Softball Throw; Shot Put (State) Discus & Javelin must use hand sanitizer between every attempt prior to using any piece of equipment.
- Avoid touching your eyes, nose, and mouth at all times.
- Line athletes on each event roster by their designated numbered cone.
  - After each group has completed their event, make sure every cone is on the painted area to ensure social distancing.



- Once your event has concluded in its entirety, completely wiped down all equipment with the provided wipes. Neatly gather all equipment and leave both pits equipment in one location. DO NOT RETURN IT TO THE SCORERS TENT IN THE INFIELD AREA.
- All field event participants will report to their events upon announcements to avoid gathering at the bullpen gate. Once they begin to arrive, the recorder at each event will need to assign them to their numbered cone to prevent gathering. Do not start until all athletes are checked in!
- Encourage athletes to go and wash their hands after exiting the infield area.
- Gathering protocols will strictly be enforced. If you hear an air horn sound one time, you are to immediately stop your event. Do not restart your event until to you hear it sound two consecutively times in a row. (there will not be a verbal announcement made prior to these sounds) If there is a race in progress, runners are to continue running. However, no race will to start until gathering has dispersed.
- Signage will be hung on exterior sides of fences to notify opposite sides of the stadium of for easier reading. There will be RED Flag signs designating the BULL PEN area at the gate if asked.
  - Visitors section is open this year – the entrance is located by the field house.
  - Every other row will be sectioned off for social distancing purposes on both sides of the stadium.
  - Staff are encouraged to also practice social distancing and avoid contact as much as possible. Wash hands as frequently as possible and use sanitize stations as frequently as possible.
- Contactless Awards: Staff will award ribbons (State) medals 1-8 call winners out by name, they will pick up their own and (State) place around their own necks.
- Contactless Timing/Judging: stand ahead of lane when the runner comes across; walk behind your place to the recording table with numbered paddle 1-8; show the paddle to the recorder; report name and time. Runners walk to awards with paper. 9+ return to bleachers.
- (State) For relay race line up – draw circles on the infield for team and social distancing.
- Track will not be open for warm ups; warm ups will be on the athletes/teams. Space is limited due to social distancing.
- (State) No opening ceremonies
- Encourage limited number of spectators; volunteers-guests-coaches-friends
- No tents are not allowed in the bleachers; along the fence around the stadium walkways; in the grass areas near the field events; or in front of the concessions area. If they are set up within the event area, they are to be removed.
- If an athlete feels sick while at an event, please direct them back to their party.
- Change gloves frequently or as often as when possible.
