Site: Mill Creek Regional Park; 1388 GA-24, Statesboro, GA 30461

Rules: This tournament will be played under the current GRPA rules. If not covered here, then refer to the rules and regulations of the National Federation of State High School rules.

Team Entry: The team entry fee is \$305.00. All entry fees must be received prior to the first game. All checks must be payable to Bulloch County Recreation & Parks; PO Box 408; Statesboro, GA 30459.

Eligibility: The 12 & Under Baseball division is for participants 12 years of age and under. The age control date is June 30, 2026. Rosters and birth certificates will be checked prior to the first game. All rosters must be typed and alphabetized on the official GRPA roster sheet. Failure to meet these requirements will result in a fine at the District and State levels.

Admission: Children (5 & under): Free, Students (6 to 17): \$4.00, Adults (18 to 60): \$8.00, Seniors (61 & up): Free

No Bills Larger than \$20.00 will be accepted

Coaches Meeting: A mandatory coaches meeting will be held 1 hour prior to each team’s first game.

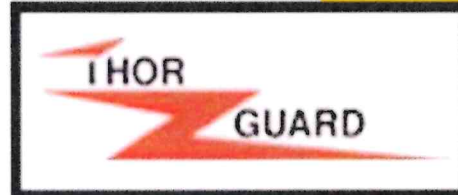
Mill Creek Regional Park is an alcohol, tobacco, and vape free facility. No pets are allowed in any facility.

Thor Guard Lightning Prediction System

“A Proactive Solution for Lightning Safety”

How it Works

- * Sensors measure and analyze the electrostatic fields in the atmosphere
- * Predicts the possible occurrence of lightning 8 - 20 minutes before it could potentially strike



Operational Statistics

- * The system has a coverage area radius of 2.5 miles
- * It is 97% accurate within a 2-mile radius
- * System operates seven days per week, from 8am - 9:30pm in the months of March - November.

When a Threat is Detected

- * Warning horn will sound with an uninterrupted 15-second blast and a strobe light will flash when there is the potential for a lightning strike within the coverage area
- * Once a threat is detected, the system continuously updates data about energy in the air 50 times per second to see if the atmosphere still retains the potential energy necessary for a lightning strike
- * Upon hearing the horn blast and/or seeing the strobe light, park users must leave the park and seek appropriate shelter

What Qualifies as Appropriate Shelter

- * Inside buildings, hard-top vehicles or other lightning protected facilities and amenities
As a Last Resort: Seek low-lying areas or dense woods

What to Avoid

- * Open areas/isolated trees
- * Water
- * Metal
- * Wire Fences
- * Overhead wires/power lines
- * Elevated ground
- * Maintenance Machinery
- * Open top or soft top vehicles



When the Threat has Diminished

- * The horn will sound three short 4-second blasts and the strobe light will turn off
- * The horn signals that normal activity may resume

Thorguard Location

- * near pond at Mill Creek Regional Park

Other Non-covered Locations

- * Signal horns may not be at your site, but at a site within ear shot. If you hear the alarm, please leave the park immediately
