

Valley League Volleyball Libero Tracking Sheet & Instructions

Enter the Libero's number next to the L. Enter the jersey number of the starting player for each position under SP. When the Libero enters, slash the player number and enter L. When the Libero leaves, slash the L and enter the returning player number. If a regular sub occurs, slash the player number and enter the new number. A Δ placed on the serving order position number indicates the only Libero serving position for that set.

1. Enter the Home and Visiting team on Tracking Sheet.
2. Next to L: put the # of the Libero being used for that set. If no Libero is being used, no tracking will take place.
3. Enter in the "SP" column the starting players for each team. This should be an exact match of the lineup entry in the scorebook.
4. When a Libero enters the set as a replacement, cross off the number of the player the Libero is replacing and put "L" on the line next to the number.
5. Caution: Only the same player's number crossed out before the "L" can be the number after. The player the Libero came into the set for can only be the Libero replacement.
6. When the Libero is replaced (again, by the same player) the "L" is crossed out and the number of the player is next entered on the line.
7. The Libero Tracker also records all substitutions. When a player (not a Libero) is substituted out of the set, their number is crossed off and the player's number entering the set is written on the line.
8. There are unlimited Libero replacements but only 18 substitutions per set.
9. Note: A different Libero can be designated for each set, but the designation must be made on the lineup sheet when it is submitted before the set.
10. The libero can serve in one rotation by replacing the player who is in the service position and who would serve the next ball.
11. When the libero serves, a triangle is used on the serving order position. This is the only position during the set the libero may serve in.
12. If a libero goes to the service position from another back row position and a "phantom" replacement takes place, the tracking sheet still needs to be noted as if the entire libero procedure exchange took place.
