Coach Responsibilities

- Contact each player on your roster ASAP. Players **can't** switch teams. You may have a parent contact you letting you know it is ok to switch – **it is not!**
- **Do not** play anyone who is not on your roster. If you don't have enough for a game, divide up the kids between the 2 teams and play. No exceptions
- We use reversible uniforms. Players keep them from season to season to re-use. Those that purchased a uniform at registration will be given to you when you pick up your roster. The names that are highlighted on the roster purchased a uniform and it will be in your bag with the child's name on it
- Size 3 Ball is used – encourage parents to send a ball
- Keep play fair. Encourage players not to push and grab opposing players
- Poor sportsmanship can result in game suspension(s) or removal as coach

Player Information

- Shin guards are required at all practices/games
- Cleats are optional
- Players must wear team jersey
- Please inform parents that jewelry needs to not be worn to games. If they do wear it, it must be covered with adhesive

Practice/Game Information

- 10 minute practice each week followed by the game. Games are (4) – 5 minute quarters
- Schedules are on Quickscores.com. Select Find My Schedule. Kaysville Recreation
- Rainout cancellations will be posted on Quickscores.com on the home page. We will play if at all possible when it rains
- The time listed on Quickscores.com is the time your practice begins
- Games and practices must begin and end on time to prevent games from getting behind. Your practice time begins at the time on the schedule regardless if the team is there. Go straight to your game if kids are late arriving
- Coach is on the field – no referee
- Practices are simple. Focus on a skill. You could focus on a skill for 2 week. Example: Dribbling, Shooting, Throw ins (the ball must be thrown in from behind the head with both hands while feet remain on the ground)
- There are many practices on YouTube – search for 3 year old soccer drills
- Start each quarter with a kick off. Alternate who kicks off each quarter
- 4 players on the field
- All players must play half of a game
- **No goal keeper is used**
