



## Kaysville City Parks and Recreation

### JR. JAZZ BASKETBALL – Kindergarten –2<sup>ND</sup> GRADE Boys & Girls

#### COACHES AND PARENTS:

- ◆ This program is an instructional program designed to teach skills.
- ◆ There will not be a referee, coaches will govern the play of the game.
- ◆ 8 foot baskets will be used.
- ◆ Each week will consist of a 20 minute practice and a game consisting of two 14 minute halves.
- ◆ Boys will play 5 VS 5 – Girls 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> grade will play 5 VS 5 – Girls Kindergarten will 4 VS 4 due to the number of players on roster
- ◆ Ball Sizes: Kindergarten – 25.5” Size 4  
1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> Grade – 27.5” – Size 5
- ◆ Players can only steal the ball on a pass. They are not allowed to swipe at or knock the ball out of the players’ hands.

#### RULES

1. Kaysville Parks & Recreation is a **ZERO TOLERANCE LEAGUE!** Coaches, parents and fans negative behavior towards the officials, coaches, and/or players will result in removal from the premises.
2. High School rules will govern play as adapted.
3. Coaches are encouraged to play each participant for an equal amount of time. It is required that each participant play the equivalent to half the game. Do not play any

player who is not on your roster.

4. The game will consist of two 14-minute halves. **The clock will run except for time outs.** Score will not be kept.
5. Man to man defense only. The teams will have colored wristbands so that they can guard the other team's player with the same-colored wristband.
6. No full court press. A defender may not guard his assigned player until they have crossed mid-court.
7. 1 time out, per team/half.
8. Coaches (one per team) may be on the court to coach their team. Please stay towards the sideline and/or baseline to stay out of the way of play. Team members should remain seated while on the sidelines.
9. Coaches, fans or players who are ejected from a game will be suspended.

NOTE: Please remember this is a FUN, instructional league. Please play all of your players and remember that no score is being kept. Coach will serve as referees, do your best to teach the game!
