

KCSL FAQ  
SPRING 2020

Welcome to the 2020 KCSL Spring Soccer Season. We are looking forward to a great year! Thanks for joining in the FUN. This flyer is intended to provide some general information to frequently asked questions.

1. The Kosciusko County Soccer League rules and regulations are guided by the US Youth Soccer.
2. The KCSL is an independent league and is not a CCAC (City-County Athletic Complex) directed league. The KCSL is a user/tenant of the CCAC. As a tenant, we have a contractual obligation to treat the park and its equipment with respect. There is a NO SMOKING policy at the soccer fields. Please pick up your trash as you exit the park. Fees could increase if additional staff is necessitated by our failure to be good stewards.
3. The season is scheduled to begin on Saturday, April 18th with 12 regular-season practice/game sessions (weather permitting) ending the week of May 25th. There will be no games on the Saturday prior to Memorial Day. Weather permitting, some age divisions will host a semi-final and championship game tournament on June 2nd and June 4th. All games and practices are held at the City-County Athletic Complex (CCAC) in Warsaw.
4. TYKES, U6 and U7 divisions will practice 30 minutes prior to their game sessions. All other divisions will practice 45 minutes prior to weekday games. The league STRONGLY URGES participants to attend all practice sessions. Practice sessions are a significant part of league participation and should be treated as such for the fairness of all players involved. Coaches may use their discretion to discipline players who miss practice sessions.
5. Players will be issued and must wear a team jersey. It is required that each player wear shin guards under socks. Players must wear dark shorts and socks that completely cover shin guards. Team jerseys must be tucked in shorts prior to games. Tennis shoes or plastic-cleated soccer shoes only. Baseball and football cleats are not allowed. All jewelry, rings, necklaces, etc must be removed prior to play. Newly pierced ears must be covered with tape or band aids. Final decisions regarding proper attire will be at the discretion of the game referee.
6. Parents and Spectators are required to view the game from the opposite side of the field from the teams. NO SPECTATORS ARE ALLOWED ALONG THE ENDLINES OR GOAL AREAS. Please remember that spectators are encouraged to cheer on their team in a positive manner. Negative comments, inappropriate behavior and foul language will not be tolerated. These rules will be strictly enforced by game officials and league officials. The league reserves the right to eject offenders, (parents, players or other spectators) from an event or for the remainder of the season.
7. **WEATHER DELAY INFORMATION:**
  - a. **Games are not cancelled until game time by the Referee on field unless previously announced by KCSL.**
  - b. **Games will typically be played in the rain unless field conditions are deemed unsafe.**
  - c. **All players PLEASE show up ready to play at practice/game time.**
  - d. **Dress warmly for rainy or cool weather.**
  - e. **Sweatshirts may be worn under team shirts; Hooded sweatshirts are recommended to have the hood tucked in; Sweatpants may be worn under shorts.**
  - f. **THE KCSL DOES NOT FOLLOW OTHER CCAC WEATHER RELATED CANCELLATIONS POLICIES (i.e. softball or baseball announcements which may be made on local radio/television.)**
8. Team Rosters: KCSL Coaches will be able to pick up team rosters around the end of March. Coaches are required to contact players as soon as possible after receiving the rosters. A Coaches meeting will be held the week before the season is scheduled to begin to receive team equipment, uniforms, final rosters, etc. This is a very important and required meeting. The league will contact each volunteer coach to provide exact details.
