
## Coaches Registration


- All Coaches sitting on the bench must be registered

- Links are only active for sports that are in season











#### **Practice**

- Coaches are responsible for putting up and taking down the nets
- Don't leave siblings unattended
- Clean up water bottles
- Check schedule often, gym times and locations can change







### **RESPECT THE SPACE**

#### **KIS Nets**

- Practice nets are located in the storage room on the North west corner of the gym
- Use the practice poles located between the bleachers
- Make sure you use the wheels on the bottom of the poles to maneuver them for both gyms

#### **KMS Nets**

- Nets and Balls are located in the storage room in the hall just before you enter the gym. There is a lock box hanging on the door combination 9011
  - Please remember to return the key to the lock box and return equipment to the storage room after practice
- Poles are located under the scoreboard and are chained to the wall
- MAKE SURE YOU RE CHAIN THEM WHEN YOU ARE DONE

If you put up the nets and no one is standing there waiting for the court you are responsible for tearing them down

# Outstanding Sportsmanship Awards

Sportsmanship Awards honor players who treat their teammates, coaches, officials, and parents respectfully and behave with integrity and self-control.

#### How does it work?

Coaches will identify at most one (1) opposing player per game, **only if deserving**, to be recognized for their outstanding sportsmanship. (*This award does not have to be given for every game or to every athlete.*) This is only awarded once per athlete per season.

- Coaches identify the Outstanding Sportsman and let the Scorers Table know.
- A game official will present the athlete(s) with a magnet
- The scorers will take a photo of the athlete(s) of the game and report on score sheet.
