Adult Co-Ed Softball Managers,

Welcome to the 2021 year of La Porte Park & Recreation Adult Co-ed Softball. The enclosed packet is all of the necessary information needed to participate in the program for the upcoming 2021 Fall Co-ed season. Please carefully read all the information in this packet. Registration Deadline is August 12th.

The roster information required for players will be *strictly enforced* this year. Rosters will not be accepted unless all information is filled out completely; including name, address, phone number and place of employment. A team must have a minimum of 12 players (6 men and 6 women) to be accepted, with a maximum of 25 players. Once the softball season has begun there will be no add-ons accepted unless it's an emergency involving a season ending injury or a special exception approved by League Director. If the add-on player is deemed necessary, an addition fee of \$5 must be paid at the time of addition.

Please look closely at the pre-season meeting date. The format will be the same as past years. We will be discussing rules, policies, procedures, and league alignment. Each team will have the opportunity to share their opinion as to what league they desire to be in, as well as, the other teams that should (or should not) be in their league. **As usual, you will need to have a team representative at the meeting to avoid a forfeit for your first game.** After this meeting, the schedules will be completed and ready to be picked up on August 30th at the Park office or electronically on Quickscores.

Again, this year, be aware, if you are planning on purchasing additional softballs please remember to purchase the NSA required softballs. We will hand out softballs with team schedules beginning August 30th. No other softball will be accepted, nor will be allowed in play. Any other softball used in play (accidentally, or otherwise) may result in an immediate forfeit.
