Adult Co-Ed Horseshoe Rules

COVID-19 RULES

- **No spectators, players are highly encouraged to leave immediately after game ends to maintain limit of 25 people at all times**
 - **Maintain 6 ft social distancing**
 - **Stay home if you are not feeling well**
 - **Hand sanitizer will be used before and after games**
 - **Horseshoes will be sanitized after each game**
 - **Time limit of 20 minutes per match will be strictly enforced to keep exposure as limited as possible.**
- 1) Each team will be responsible for keeping track of their own score.
 - 2) Each game will last until someone reaches 21 points or the time limit of 20 minutes is reached. You must win by 2 in order to win. Cap at 25 points.
 - 3) Each team will play the best 2 of 3 games.
 - 4) The total win-loss record for the team will be used for placing teams in the tournament brackets at the end of the season.
 - 5) You can find the schedule and win-loss record at www.quickscores.com/lasalle.
 - 6) You must stand on the side of the stake not directly in front of the stake. Women can go up to white line and Men have to go to the front of the stake.

Scoring

1. Any shoe must be within one horseshoe-width (measured across the outside of the open end of the shoe) of the stake to be considered for points. (Official rules call for 6 inches max).
2. The closest shoe to the stake gets 1 point.
3. If you have two shoes closer than any of your opponent's, you get 2 points.
4. Ringers are worth 3 points each and must completely encircle the stake so the ends can be touched with a straight-edge without touching the stake.
5. If you have the closest shoe and a ringer, it's 4 points.
6. If your opponent throws a ringer on top of yours, they cancel and no points are scored.

Please keep all remarks and conversation appropriate for all ages. Personal attacks against staff and/or other players will not be tolerated and could result in the forfeiture of the game and the rest of the season.
