

SPORTSMANSHIP GRADING POLICY

Teams must receive an average of a C grade to be eligible for tournament.

Excellent Conduct and Sportsmanship ("A" Grade)

- Team members cooperate with and demonstrate good sportsmanship toward members of opposing team, spectators, and ALL Recreation staff.
- Coach/captain exhibits control over his/her team and spectators, converses reasonably and rationally with officials about rule interpretations, and cooperates by providing any information requested by any recreation staff member.

Good Conduct and Sportsmanship ("B" Grade)

- Team members verbally complain about some decisions made by the officials and/or show minor dissensions, which may or may not merit an un-sportsmanlike conduct penalty.
- Teams that receive one un-sportsmanlike conduct penalty will receive no higher than a "B" grade.

Average Conduct and Sportsmanship ("C" Grade)

- Team shows verbal dissent towards officials and/or the opposing team, which may or may not merit an un-sportsmanlike conduct penalty.
- Coach/captain exhibits minor control over team/spectators but is in control of himself/herself.
- Team fails to appear at their scheduled game.
- Teams receiving multiple un-sportsmanlike conduct penalties will receive no higher than a "C" grade.

Below Average Conduct and Sportsmanship ("D" Grade)

- Team constantly complains to the officials and/or opposing team from the field/court/sidelines.
- Coach/captain exhibits little or no control over team/spectators or him/herself.
- Teams that have a player ejected will receive no higher than a "D" grade.

Poor Conduct and Sportsmanship ("F" Grade)

- Team is completely un-cooperative; coach has no control over team/spectators/self.
- Teams play with ineligible participants or withhold any information requested.
- Damage or destruction of any facility/equipment.
- Any threatening behavior (verbal/nonverbal) towards any player, spectator, or recreation staff member.
- Any team with multiple player ejections or causing a forfeit for any reason other than not having enough players will receive an "F" rating.

ALL GRADES WILL BE DETERMINED BY THE REFEREES AND GYM SUPERVISOR. IT IS UP TO THEIR JUDGMENT AS TO WHICH GRADE YOU GET!!

Grades can be averaged. (A, A-, B+, B, B-, C+, C, C-, D+, D, D-, F)
