



## **COVID-19 Adjustments for Baseball:**

- **Before games start, all coaches will symptom check their own players. All players must pass a symptom check before the game can begin. Coaches will report that the checks have been completed to the umpires.**
- **Spectators are limited to 2 per player & should stay on the grass areas on the outside of the field. No spectators will be allowed to watch the game past the dugouts.**
- **Participants are encouraged to use their own equipment.**
- **Restrooms will be available but, participants are encouraged to use the restroom at home before coming to the park.**
- **Hand Sanitizer will be available in all dugouts.**
- **No coaches, players or spectators will be allowed in the score tower. All lineups will be turned in to the drop box at the bottom of the stairs 15 minutes before the scheduled game time.**
- **The bleachers will be used for “dugouts”. When a team is on the field, only 2 coaches are allowed in the dugout. When a team is at bat, only the player on deck and the player in the hole can be in the dugout. All other players must stay in the bleachers.**
- **Between innings, teams must still social distance and take turns passing through the dugouts. All dugouts will be sanitized in between games.**
- **Base coaches are still asked to follow proper social distancing during gameplay.**
- **Sanitizing supplies will be available for all participants to sanitize equipment during the game. All dugouts will be sanitized between games.**
- **No handshakes or team huddles at the end of the game. Feel free to tip your hat or clap for the other team as a sign of good sportsmanship.**
- **Please do not pass out treats at the end of games. Parents can provide treats for their own child(ren).**
- **All teams must leave the park as soon as the game is over – no team meetings at the park.**
- **There will be no UBBA state tournament this season. The season will end after the Lehi City tournament.**

***Note: All Lehi City employees will wear a face mask, when necessary, to properly follow the social distancing recommendations.***
