



## **COVID-19 Adjustments for Flag Football:**

- **Before games start, all coaches will symptom check their own players. All players must pass a symptom check before the game can begin. Coaches will report that the checks have been completed to the officials.**
- **Spectators are limited to 2 per player. Spectators need to social distance.**
- **The team designated areas will be marked with paint. We ask that all spectators remain behind the spectator lines, allowing the participants enough room. Home team spectators are to sit on the North [Fields B, D, 2, 3, 5] or East [Fields A & C] sideline of their field. Away team spectators are to sit on the South [Fields B, D, 2, 3, 5] or West [Fields A & C] sideline of their field. No spectators are allowed on the end zone lines.**
- **Restrooms will be available, but participants and spectators are encouraged to use the restroom at home before coming to the park.**
- **Hand Sanitizer will be available at all parks with our sanitation crew staff.**
- **During timeouts and halves, we ask that all participants continue to social distance.**
- **Coaches are still asked to follow proper social distancing during gameplay.**
- **No handshakes or team huddles at the end of the game. Feel free to clap for the other team as a sign of good sportsmanship.**
- **Please do not pass out treats at the end of games. Parents can provide treats for their own child(ren).**
- **All teams must leave the park as soon as the game is over – no team meetings at the park.**
- **There will not be an organized picture day this season, but parents are welcome to take pictures at any of their games or practices.**
- **Equipment bags will be given out to coaches at the beginning of the season. Coaches can bring their equipment by for the Sanitation Crew to sanitize during any of the games. Our Sanitation Crew will be located near the restrooms.**

***Note: All Lehi City employees will wear a face mask, when necessary, to properly follow the social distancing recommendations.***
