



## **COVID-19 Adjustments for Women's Volleyball:**

- **Before all games start, all players and spectators will be symptom checked upon arrival at the Legacy Center. If anybody does not pass the symptom check, they will not be able to participate. Please plan accordingly as games have a forfeit time for when teams arrive to their assigned gym.**
- **Teams will not be allowed to arrive early to practice before games in the hallway or other gyms. Teams should plan to show up on time and only go into their assigned gym.**
- **Spectators are limited to 2 per player & should stay on the bleachers. If a child is present, there must be an adult spectator watching the child. A player cannot supervise children while playing. Spectators will not switch sides when their team switches sides.**
- **All spectators will be required to wear a face mask upon entering the gym and for the duration of each game.**
- **All spectators must watch the games from the gyms. No spectators will be allowed to watch upstairs from the mezzanine.**
- **Restrooms will be available, but participants are encouraged to use the restroom at home before coming to the facility to help minimize traffic.**
- **Water fountains will be available, but participants are encouraged to bring their own water bottle with their name written on the bottle.**
- **Hand Sanitizer will be available in all gyms.**
- **All bleachers will be sanitized in between each game.**
- **All players are still asked to follow proper social distancing before games, during down time, in between sets and after games.**
- **Sanitizing supplies will be available for all participants to sanitize equipment during the game, if necessary.**
- **No handshakes or team huddles at the end of the game or in between sets. Feel free to cheer or clap for the other team as a sign of good sportsmanship.**
- **All teams must leave the Legacy Center as soon as the game is over – no team meetings after the games have finished.**

***Note: All Lehi City employees will wear a face mask, when necessary, to properly follow the social distancing recommendations.***
