Please inquire with each individual program about how teams are formed, divided, and regarding team uniforms, as different rules may apply.

Rules and Guidelines

USA rules will govern play with the following modifications:

- A. No new inning after 70 minutes. If the home team is batting at the 70 minute mark, and CANNOT score the necessary runs to win the game, the game will end. Otherwise the game will continue until the home team either scores the winning run or 3 outs are achieved. Games called for weather or other reasons will be an official game after 60 minutes or 4 innings.
- B. A 10 run rule will be used: after 60 minutes, a team ahead by 10 or more runs at the end of an inning will be the winner.
- C. Less than 7 players will be a forfeit. A 5 minute grace period will be given at the start of each game if necessary.
- D. No automatic out will be in effect if there are 8 or more players. 7 players would constitute one automatic out.
- E. Home team will be determined by a coin toss. Home team will take the 3rd base dugout.
- F. 6 run maximum per inning.
- G. 10 players will be allowed on defense. The 10th player must play in the outfield.
- H. Free defensive substitutions. Pitchers may return to the pitching mound once if left on defense.
- I. No infield practice is to be held before game time.
- J. Players and coaches will not be allowed to trade any player(s) to a different team. The Recreation Staff reserves the right to check a player's identity with the roster at any time. Any player found participating, which is not on the official team roster, will forfeit the game for the team he/she was playing on. If a team is caught a second time their team will be dropped from the league or tournament with no refund.
- K. Good sportsmanship is required from all coaches, players, and spectators.
- L. **Coaches must play all their players on their roster. Late players will be placed at the bottom of the line-up.**
