

Lexington Men's Senior Softball League season ready to get underway

The 2026 Lexington Men's Senior Softball League season is set to get underway this upcoming week, as all seven teams that competed in the league last year are back again this year to start a 14-game regular season schedule. The seven teams will all play four of the other six squads twice, and the other two teams three times each.

Similar to last year each team will usually play one game each week starting with the opening games this Tuesday night. Regular season play will continue through late July or early August, before the seven teams will start to compete in a double-elimination playoff to determine this year's league champion.

This year the Five-O's are once again the defending champion after taking back the league title last year from Prime Time, the squad that took the title away from the Five-O's in 2024. The Five-O's also capturing three straight league titles from 2021 to 2023, and will be trying to win its fifth league championship in six years. Besides the Five-O's and Prime Time, the other five squads that will compete for this year's league title are Foul Play, Metro Contracting, MJB Consulting, Midnight Express, and the Goodtimers.

Similar to last year, the regular season games are scheduled at Estabrook field on Tuesday and Thursday nights starting at 6:30, and two games at the Center 2 field on Tuesday nights starting at 6:30 and 8:15. Regular season play begins this Tuesday, May 5th, with the Goodtimers playing Foul Play at Estabrook field at 6:30, while Metro Contracting will battle Midnight Express at 6:30 and Prime Time will duel MJB Consulting at 8:15 at the Center 2 field. The Five-O's will open defense of its league title against Metro Contracting the following Thursday at Estabrook field at 6:30 to cap the first week of play.
