

Prime Time, Metro Win To Get Back On The Right Track

Although a third straight Thursday night game when the sun was shining was postponed, the Lexington Men's Senior Softball League still managed to play a limited slate of two games this past week. Prime Time continued to put its opening-game setback behind it with a second straight win, while Metro Contracting bounced back from a pair of opening losses to capture its first victory of the season.

Since losing to the Five-O's on the league's opening night Prime Time has appeared to have found a key to success over the last two weeks. After a convincing win over the Goodtimers two weeks ago, Prime Time continued to surge with another victorious effort this past week.
