Code of Conduct: Participant Guidelines

Equal Access

No eligible participant shall, on the basis of race, creed, national origin or disability, be denied equal access to programs, activities, services or benefits or be limited in the exercise of any right, privilege, advantage or opportunity. If any special accommodations are necessary for participation in any program or to receive any service provided by the Lombard Park District, please notify the staff upon registration.

<u>Behavior</u>

All participants are expected to exhibit appropriate behavior at all times while participating, spectating or attending any program or activity sponsored by the Lombard Park District. This includes participation in programs which may or may not require an admission fee, spectating at athletic events, concerts, etc., attending the Paradise Bay Water Park, Madison Meadow Athletic Center, or attending special events such as Lilac Time, Summer Movies and Concerts, Teen & Family Nights, Teen Dances, Fall Fest and Holiday Lights among others.

For the purpose of the Code of Conduct, the term "program" refers to all recreational events as a participant, spectator or visitor which are sponsored by the Lombard Park District and for all Lombard Park District facilities. These following guidelines are designed to provide safe and enjoyable activities for all participants. Additional Codes of Conduct may apply for particular programs such as day camps, athletic leagues and the water park.

Participants shall:

- 1) Show respect to all participants and program staff and/or supervisors.
- 2) Take direction from program staff/supervisors.
- 3) Refrain from using abusive or foul language.
- 4) Refrain from causing bodily harm to self, other participants or program staff/supervisors.
- 5) Show respect for equipment, supplies and facilities.

<u>Discipline</u>

A positive approach is used when disciplining. Program staff/supervisors may discuss the Code of Conduct with all program participants prior to the start of the program and will periodically review the Code of Conduct. If inappropriate behavior occurs, staff will develop a solution specific to each situation as it arises. The Lombard Park District reserves the right to dismiss a participant whose behavior endangers the safety of himself/herself and/or others.
