Agenda items: Fall Season, to have or not to have.

All communities spoke and voted regarding a fall season or not.

1. Amherst – Yes - Per Chris Kelly, Ohio travel is a go currently. Ohio travel next meeting, July 26th
2. Columbia – Yes - Scott was not present however communicated with Paul that his community wants a fall season.
3. Edison – Yes - Dennis expressed concerns about safely having a fall season. Player count may be low for fall. Registration has not started. Schools did okay the use of the fields.
4. Elyria – Yes – No fields still but they are looking for alternate options for games and practices. Elyria school details for return to school this fall have not been distributed. If there is online only school in the fall Elyria will not have players play in the fall.
5. Firelands – Yes – Although there is concern about what happens if we play a few weeks then it is cancelled. How does that effect costs, refunds, etc....
6. Lagrange – Yes – School for this city has not published their return to fall plans. They plan to have them July 28th. If still in Phase II, they will do an intracity play option
7. Lorain – Yes – If a traditional season cannot commence, Lorain will do an intracity season
8. Midview – Yes – They want a season even if that means no games or travel.
9. Oberlin – Yes – Bryan will check with the city to ensure they are permitted to play on the fields
10. Sheffield Lake – Yes – Yes to a traditional season. No if it is only intracity play
11. Vermillion – Yes – Will do intracity play if traditional season is not an option
12. Wellington – Yes/No – Would prefer a delayed season and review in a month. There is concern about coach's safety and responsibility for the players. How to abide by state laws and still provide a safe environment.
13. President / Paul – Yes

It was decided we will move forward with a fall season. Communities can opt out of the season or combine with nearby communities if needed.

SEASON INFO:

To be able to start practice and be on the fields all registrations needs to be completed and sent to Heidi.
This requires signed Infectious Disease Waiver and Lindsay Law.

Team Commitments –

- It is imperative to include any scheduling restrictions or limitations at the time you turn in your team commitments. Make sure to outline those limitations in an email.
 - i.e. Coach Doe coaches two teams or no games for Coach Smith on Tuesdays etc.
- There will not be a two-week time frame to reschedule. It will likely be 2-3 days

Safety Checks – PLAYER AND COACHES

- All safety procedures outlined by Ohio North and the State of Ohio must be adhered to.
 - Temperature checks
 - Bringing their own ball
 - Bringing their own drink
 - Not coming early or staying late
 - More listed on quickscores website.
- Spectators should space out and can be around the 3 sides of the fields but not directly behind the goalie net to give spectators more room to spread out.
 - Spectators should also be 6 feet back from the sidelines during games

Season End Classic –

- There will be no classic this fall season

Paul motioned, Chris Kelly second, majority agreed:

- Player and Coach cost of \$11 each go to OYSAN. Once a team is submitted and approved that fee cannot be refunded by OYSAN.
- Heidi will have completed full registrar duty and will receive her salary in full at the beginning of the season.
- Player registration is due by August 1. All communities should send Heidi teams by then. If some come in afterwards, but before August 8th the team late fee will be waived.

Paul motioned, Rachel Rush second, majority agreed:

- Team commitments due August 10th
- Schedule will not be paid until the end of the season. If season is cancelled scheduler will not be paid. Saves \$1,500

Paul motioned, Laura Johnson second, majority agreed:

- If the season is cancelled team commitment fees can be refunded depending on when the season is cancelled
 - Prior to 1st game, full refund of team commitments
 - Games 1-3 played - team commitment fees prorated and refunded
 - Games 4-8 played – team commitments fees nonrefundable
