New Business:

1. Vote - Recalculate Classic fees. Motion to change to flat fee per team has been made. Motioned by Chris and 2nd by Ben, all were in favor. No one opposed. Motion passed. Spring Classic fees will be as follows:

- U7/U8 - \$50 per team
- U9/U10 - \$60 per team
- U11/U12 - \$70 per team
- U13/U14/U15 - \$90 per team

Team Commitment Discussion:

1. U7/U8 will have 3 divisions A, B, and C.
 - a. Bryan will arrange to have 3 U8 fields for the classic. We want to try not to have them play on U9 field.
2. U10 and up, large divisions but not enough teams to split.
3. U13/14 division, Try to have no 8th graders *unable to do a true U13
4. U14/15 division, Mostly 8th graders.
5. Wellington – How many U15 players. Paul advised any other community would accept 8th graders so they don't miss their last season in county and chance to play at the classic.

 - vi. Trophies are for players that attend the classic only. We will not pass out extra trophies.
