

2026 Junior Major Baseball

Lincoln City, Nestucca, Newport, Siletz, Waldport

On January 20th, 2026 at the Newport Recreation Center a meeting was held with at least one representative from each above organization. During that meeting it was agreed upon to follow the JBO rules for the National Level of play during Recreational League games. With emphasis or adjustments, as follows:

- 1) A Parents Code of Conduct was signed by each registrant, enforcement is the responsibility of the home team coach, including ejection(s) from a game(s).
- 2) Neck, throat guard, must be worn on catcher's helmets.
- 3) Play with your roster whenever possible. If additional players are needed to supplement your roster, you must call the opposing coach 24 hours ahead of time and offer to reschedule the game. If players are added to your roster, no more than 9 players are allowed on your roster. Each player that is not on your team is only allowed to play an outfield position, and must bat at the bottom of the batting order.
- 4) No infield fly rule.
- 5) No straight steal of home. Advancing to home on a passed ball or wild pitch is allowed.
- 6) X.1.J. There will be a five-run rule per inning with the final inning open. The umpire must declare, prior to the start of any inning, that this is the final inning, based on the following conditions: time restriction, field condition, darkness or the fifth inning (for ties, see rule VIII letter W).
- 7) Except pitch counts and time limits, there will be no rule changes for tournament play. Pitch counts & time limit rules will follow JBO National Minor League rules.
- 8) It is the head coach's responsibility to report pitch counts on GameChanger.
