Nestucca Youth Baseball and Softball (NYBS) recognizes the significant impact a coach has on the lives of their players. A coach should always strive to provide a positive experience for all their players. Youth sports is an opportunity for an athlete to develop not only their athletic skills, but also their character. Coaches play a vital role in that process, so we expect our coaches to treat players, other coaches, umpires and parents with respect and dignity.

Coaches commit to the following Code of Conduct as a coach for the NYBS:

1. First and foremost, I will place the emotional and physical wellbeing of my players ahead of personal desire to win.
2. I will do my best to provide a safe playing situation for all players.
3. I will lead by example in demonstrating fair play and sportsmanship to all players.
4. I will be knowledgeable in the rules of the sport that I coach, understand their intent and I will teach these rules to my players.
5. I am obligated by this code of conduct to make every effort to complete the game and practice schedule as it is written.
6. I will do my best to organize practices that are fun and challenging for all my players.
7. I will provide a sports environment free of drugs, tobacco, and alcohol.
8. I understand that I may never remove my team from the playing field or court during or prior to a scheduled game in protest.
9. I will remember that I am a youth sports coach, and that the game is for children and not adults.
