OFFICE HOURS

Office hours will be posted on our website pasodelnortesoccer.com and on front office front door.

REGISTRATION PROCESS

- Team Registration Form
- Register all players through the provided link on GotSport.com (Link can be found on pasodelnortesoccer.com)
- Coaches must have current USYS 'Safe Sport', 'Heads Up', and 'Background Check' in order to receive IDs and Roster (Fall Season new IDs) (Spring season updated sticker)

The registration of over 5000 players is a huge task and ID cards will not be given out right away, the office staff needs time to upload information into the system.

FIELD MARSHALLS/ LEAGUE OFFICIALS

PDN may designate Field Marshalls to monitor teams, coaches and fans.

Paso del Norte Staff will conduct random "ON THE SPOT" roster checks, they will be carried out randomly throughout the season. Everyone playing must be registered on the official team roster and have an ID card, coaches as well. It is the coaches responsibility to make sure all players meet the requirements 48 hours before game time.

REFEREE ASSAULT & ABUSE

- ALL PLAYERS AND PARENTS WILL BE ON THEIR SIDE OF THE FIELD AND BEHIND MARKED AND DESIGNATED AREAS, **NO EXCEPTIONS !!**
- Coaches and Assistant coaches need to wear their coaches card at all times, practice & games.
- Referee assault of any kind, verbal or physical, by a player, coach or parent will not be tolerated.
- Coaches are responsible for the conduct of their team and parents, game will be forfeited if coaches cannot control their fans and parents. It is the responsibility of coaches, assistant coaches and team managers to familiarize themselves with PDN rules and policies.
- As warranted by PDN, it maintains the right to enforce a three game automatic suspension for verbal abuse.
- Physical assault by a parent, player or coach will go through a D&P process according to STYSA disciplinary procedures, the player, coach or parent will be suspended until a decision has been made.
- Referee's and league officials have the right to stop a game and call El Paso Police department if coaches or parent fail to leave the fields if he/she is ejected. Game will be forfeited by the league against the offending team regardless of the score at the time of infraction.

ILLEGAL PLAYERS

An illegal player will be suspended until a D&P hearing is held. The coach who played the ineligible player will also be suspended pending a D&P hearing



TRANSFER POLICY

- Only (3) transfers will be allowed per season per team, before roster freeze.
 - A transfer means a player who is on the roster of another team.
 - Additional transfers will be approved only by the PDN board on a case by case bases.
 - No transfers allowed after the 2nd game of season league play
 - A single player can only be transferred twice during the season.
- **ONLY NEW PLAYERS WILL BE ADDED, IF THE TEAM HAS ROOM ON THEIR ROSTER**
- New player means, a player who has not registered for the season.
