Division Playoffs:

- American Division:
 - Should one team win both sessions. No playoff.
 - In the event each session (2) is won by two different teams, the team with the best overall record will be designated as the home team.
- National Division:
 - o The National Division has three thirteen games sessions.
 - o Should one team win all three sessions, no playoff.
 - In the event one team wins two of the sessions and another team wins one of the sessions, the team with the best overall record of the three sessions will be designated as the home team.
 - o In the event each of the three sessions is won by a different team, The team with the best overall record will have a bye.
 - The remaining two teams will play a one game knockout game. The team that had the second-best overall record will be the home team. The winner of this matchup will then play the team that received the bye. The home team would be the team that received the bye.
