### **Meeting Topics:**

#### **Fall/Winter Registrations:**

- Current registrations show that currently twenty-one teams (Eight American League and Thirteen National League) with eleven players per team.
- > National League could be split into two divisions. Further discussion.
- > The possibility exists that there may be some "Ghost Players" required.
- > The above numbers are subject to change after registrations close on August 1.
- Eleven players registered as "Subs Only"

### **Game Days and Game Times:**
