## General Rules

- The average rating of playing managers will be determined prior to the start of the draft.
- Rounds 1 and 2 of the draft will be conducted prior to the main draft date, but no sooner than completion of player evaluations.
- Ties will be resolved based upon the order of the previous round. The team that picked higher in the prior round will pick lower in the current round. This applies to rounds 3-12.
- There may be no more than two people per team represented in the draft room. This includes the manager (or his/her designee) and their $1^{\text {st }}$ Round pick OR someone associated with the team.
- There will be a group of pitchers established. Each team must choose one pitcher and only one pitcher by the end of the $6^{\text {th }}$ round. Beginning in the $7^{\text {th }}$ round, if there are any pitchers remaining from this group, they can now be drafted.
- At the end of round 12 , all teams must be within 3 points, plus or minus.
- There will be a one minute time limit for picks through round 6.
- There will be a very short break after round 6.
- There will be a two minute time limit for picks during rounds 7-12
- A player that also sponsors the team he/she is assigned will be considered the manager of that team.
- There will be two boards:
- Board A - consists of all players that have registered for the draft that were on a team roster or a paid member of the PCSSA during the 2017-18 fall - winter league. (This does not include those only on spring teams) All players on Board A will be drafted.
- Board B - consists of all new players that have registered for the current draft and all returning players that missed a season or more and were not on an active roster or a paid member of the PCSSA for the 2017-18 fall-winter league. The number that can be drafted from Board B will be determined prior to draft day, dependent on the number of players required to fill out the teams. This determined number of players may be drafted at any time during the draft, but once this number has been reached then only players on the A Board may be drafted.
Any remaining players that were not drafted will be placed on the sub list.
- Trades may be made immediately after the draft is complete. There is a twenty minute time limit to agree and announce trades. All trades are team to team, number by number (plus or minus 1 point), and player by player. There are no multiple team trades or multiple player trades.
- The Vice-President will make the final decision for any issues not covered in the draft process.


## First Round

- Non-playing managers will draw cards to determine the order of their picks. Draft order will be highest card to the lowest card.
- Non-playing managers may pick any eligible player with a rating equal to or not less than four points below the average of all playing managers


## Second Round

- Team total points will be summarized.
- Ties will be resolved.
- If non-playing mangers are tied, the tie will be resolved based upon the order of the previous round. The team that picked higher in the prior round will pick lower in the current round.
- If playing managers are tied, they will use a card draw to determine the order. Highest card goes first to the lowest card last.
- Managers will pick in order with the lowest total number picking first.


## Third Round through Final Round

- Team total points will be summarized.
- Ties will be resolved based on the order of the previous round.
- Team total points, average points, and average points needed, will be monitored to insure balance.
- Managers will pick in order with the lowest point total number picking first.


## After the draft

- Manager will contact all players on their team to verify shirt sizes and numbers.
- Uniforms will be ordered NO later than date determined by vendor. All orders will be final. Please state any need for additional shirts, caps/visors or special requests of Sponsor
- NO Pizza and refreshments after the draft.


## Manager Sponsor Guidelines

Managers and Sponsors will be selected/assigned in the following priority:

- Returning managers will retain their previous sponsor if they want to and the sponsor is available.
- All remaining sponsors will be available for choosing.
- Managers will decide among themselves which sponsor they want to represent.

If managers are unable to come to a final decision, the Board will make the final assignment.
