	<p>An assembly was held in response to Bob's 8/16/25 League Notice, allowing members to ask questions about the league in an open format. Following the general assembly, National League (NL) Managers were invited to attend a closed door meeting to discuss ideas about pitching options in the NL</p> <p>Members had questions about the new rules for the 25/26 season and the rationale behind them. All questions were addressed. Members were given an update on the parking lot and storage improvements that PCSSA is working on with the HOA.</p> <p>The board revised the wording of the "home run rule" from "one up plus walk" to "one up plus single" to align with its intended purpose. This modification seeks to minimize intentional walks and uneven scoring without penalizing the batter. Consequently, instead of multiple home runs being declared an out, the batter and all base runners will advance one base as if a single were hit. Home runs will be counted when there are an equal number of home runs recorded by each team.</p> <p>Jan Hangen requested that the board consider buying a storage box for the current shed to be installed after he cleans it out. Bob received a copy of the box and approximate cost and stated that the board would consider its purchase. Additionally, Jan requested permission to purchase low cost items for the tractor i.e. oil and air filters to prepare it for the upcoming season. He was given approval to proceed with the tractor work as he deemed necessary.</p>
