



### **Fall/Winter Season Comes to an End**

The 2023-2024 Fall/Winter season finally came to an end yesterday with a final round of American League games to be played. The final standings are as follows:

In the National League, West Valley Golf Cars, led by manager Len Maitland, won both halves of the league championship to finish with a record of 32-7. As a result, there will be no overall championship.

In the Mid-American League, Argent Solar, led by co-managers Ed Schneider and Bobby Freiberg, won the second half championship, to join Hong Dentistry, led by manager Brian Wagner, who won the first half championship. Argent finished with an overall record of 29-11, while Hong finished with an overall record of 28-12. The two teams will meet in the league championship game on April 1<sup>st</sup>.

In the American League, Edward Jones Investments, led by manager Scott Flynn, won the second half championship, to join Woodbury Financial, who won the first half championship. Woodbury Financial and Edwards Jones both finished with identical records of 29-10. The two teams will meet in the league championship game on April 1<sup>st</sup>.

### **League Championships**

The two league championship games will be played on April 1<sup>st</sup>, with the Mid-American League game scheduled for 12:00 noon and the American League game scheduled for 1:15 PM, weather permitting.

### **End of Year Tournaments**

The end of year tournaments are scheduled to begin on Tuesday, April 2<sup>nd</sup>, involving all teams in their respective leagues, competing in a single elimination format. The league tournaments will continue throughout the week, with championship games scheduled for Saturday, April 6<sup>th</sup>.

Opening day is Tuesday, April 9<sup>th</sup> and the season will run for six weeks, ending on May 18<sup>th</sup>. Game days are Tuesday, Thursday and Saturday, beginning at 8:00 AM. The order of the games will alternate between the two leagues from game day to game day to promote intermingling of players from the two leagues.
