Spring Season Registration

PLEASE REGISTER EARLY

Spring season registration opens today, February 1st, and closes February 29th. The registration form may be found on the PCSSA website under "Registrations." The player draft is scheduled for March 4th.

Opening day is April 9th and the season will run for 6 weeks, ending on May 18th. Game days are Tuesday, Thursday and Saturday.

There will be two leagues: American and Mid-American (combined with National). It is anticipated there will be 4-5 teams in each league, divided by player ratings.

Everyone registering as a player will be drafted and provided with a jersey and hat. Those registering as a sub only may wear their team uniform and hat from the current Fall/Winter season. All players, including subs, will be required to wear softball pants or shorts (black or grey) matching the team color choice.

Further details will be announced immediately following the registration period once we know the number of teams, player ratings, etc. PCSSA volunteer umpires will officiate all Spring season games.

The following registration fees will apply:

- \$70 – Player Fee
- \$40 – Assistant Manager/Coach Fee
- \$40 – Sub Fee (if not on a Fall/Winter roster)
- \$20 – Sub List (if player has own jersey from Fall/Winter season)
