



Frank Onzo Sportsmanship Award Guidelines

In recognition of Frank Onzo, an original PebbleCreek Senior Softball Association Player, an award has been established to honor him and remember his dedication to the PCSSA. This award will be presented to one individual who demonstrates the qualities of friendship, sportsmanship and care for the well-being of fellow members of the PCSSA, much like Frank did during his tenure. Frank was always open minded in his thoughts and he displayed a charisma that made every individual he came in contact with feel good about their personal association with the PCSSA. The individual selected for this award must reflect Frank's qualities.

The selection of the recipient for this award will be made by the Board of Directors based upon nominations presented by each team through their respective coach or designated representative. Nominations must be in writing and must outline the reasoning why that particular individual should be recognized. Each nominee must be currently active in the PCSSA and must have been active in PebbleCreek softball for the last three seasons. The criteria for nomination might give consideration to the additional following areas of contribution: -

- Team Management
- Board Membership
- Serving on committees for various administrative functions for the league
- Field maintenance/preparation throughout the year
- Leadership qualities on or off the field
- Total development of the League
- Volunteer work
- One who can always be depended upon to make a difference.

The above criteria are only suggestions for consideration. All nominees will be given a complete evaluation based upon the write up he or she receives, while keeping in mind that individuals contribution to the league. Promoting sportsmanship, friendship and a level of dedication to PebbleCreek softball is paramount. After review of all write-ups, the board will announce the winner at the end of year social activity for the league.
