POLICY STATEMENT #7  
Years of Service Accumulation and  
Acknowledgement

The PCSSA League Historian tracks all members of the League, both past and present. He/she also documents when a player steps away from the League and if they return (break in tenure). In this case, the historian is careful to differentiate their service to those of actual participation and not just seasons since their rookie season and adjust years.

Only participation in the Fall/Winter league is counted if/when a player is rostered on a team. Participation in Spring League or summer pick-up games is not counted.

Seasons of participation (years of service) are accumulated at the CONCLUSION of a season. They are not credited at the start of the season. Think of this as a player who has completed 15 years of service rather than starting their 15<sup>th</sup> year.

#### AWARDS

At the conclusion of 15 seasons of service, the player is awarded a 15-year pin, patch on uniform and PCSSA jacket.

At the conclusion of 20 seasons of service, the player is awarded a 20-year pin and patch on uniform.

At the conclusion of 25 seasons of service, the player is awarded a plaque, 25-year pin and patch on uniform.

After the conclusion of 25 seasons of service, the player's patch will display each year of service after the conclusion of the next season (example: 26 year patch after 26 years, 27 year patch after 27 years, etc.).

At the conclusion of 30 seasons of service, the player is awarded a 30-year pin and patch on uniform.

Awards will be presented at the end of season league banquet or final event.

The de facto League Historian is Steve Ward.
