# PCSSA Field Preparation Guidelines – April 06, 2023

### To be performed by the softball team players

#### Infield

## **Bench and Spectator Area**

Sweep stones, dirt, debris and leaves from sidewalks, concrete and paver areas on visitor side and on home side

Wash off or wipe down seating areas (there are two buckets in the shed, one containing clean cloths and the other for dirty (used) cloths. **Use clean cloths sparingly!** Get water from the hose on the side of the shed and use a pail to wash out the cloths while using them. Rinse them out again with clean water after the last use and before hanging them to dry on the pail edge. Make sure water valve is shut off before leaving.

Wipe down water fountain and tops of garbage cans with wet cloths

If clothing, a glove, etc., is left at the park, put it in the lost-and-found on top of the fridge

If you see anything else that requires attention (trash, etc), take care of it. # Warm-up area

Sweep batting tee mat area to keep clear of rocks/debris

Hand drag or broom the warm-up area

Tidy up bucket of balls and practice bats if needed

Sweep off the pitching rubber and plate

## **Equipment Garage (Shed)**

Put things back in the proper place and try to keep shed neat. Put things back where you found them instead of just chucking stuff inside.

Keep shed floor free of debris – sweep it if necessary

NOTE – Failure by a team to complete the tasks as listed will be addressed by the Board, and may result in action being taken against that team.
