## **INFORMATION**



- GAME LOCATION Games will be played at Shannon Fields (220 S. 420 W.) located by the Rodeo grounds.
- **PRACTICES** TBD by Coach
- **LEAGUE SHIRT/HAT** Registration fee includes a league team t-shirt and hat that will be handed out to coaches on the first game day.
- Coaches Background Checks PG City requires all coaches in any of the city youth programs to complete a background screen. If you are a new coach and have not had a background screen with the Recreation Department you will be asked to apply online.

## **RULES**

- 1. The game time as shown on schedule is starting time. Please encourage your players to be at the field on time. Games should last 50 minutes.
- 2. Coaches are responsible for getting the games started on their field and to keep it moving along.
- 3. Coaches are encouraged to rotate players to a new defensive position each inning.
- 4. The coach of the team batting is responsible for placing the ball on the tee. <u>Please have assistant coaches or parents making sure players in line to bat are at a safe distance away from the person batting.</u>
- 5. Coaches are allowed on the field to assist their team while playing defense. They are there to help direct the players.
- 6. No score is kept! This league is for fun and to promote basic skills and knowledge!!
- 7. Soft safety balls will be used at all times.
- 8. The ball is hit off a batting tee. There is no pitching allowed to more advanced players.
- 9. Everyone bats and plays in the field. Teams switch after last batter's turn is over. <u>To assure</u> more innings please have kids hustle on and off the field.
- 10. The coach of the team batting will remove the tee from the playing field after the ball is hit.

- 11. No stealing bases. Player stays on the base until the ball is hit.
- 12. The catcher's mask must be worn by the catcher.
- 13. Safety helmets shall be worn when batting and running bases.
- 14.Players shall not wear anything dangerous to themselves or other players, such as watches, rings, hats, earrings, casts, etc. Wrapping of casts is not acceptable.
- 15. Coaches can call outs to teach basic knowledge of game, but kids will continue to run the bases.
- 16. Supervisor will sound horn at end of game time. This signifies that ONE more batter will be allowed to bat before game is completed.
- 17. To promote a clean environment at the fields' spectators, players, & coaches are reminded to pick up any garbage left by your team after each game.
- 18. Remember: This league is for fun!!
